**Fire Blanket or Extinguisher?** You should always have an extinguisher in addition to your fire blanket, but choosing which to use in the moment depends on the fire. Only training, learning and experience can tell you which. However, fire blankets don't run out of water or foam, don't leave any messy residue behind, and are cheaper to replace than extinguishers.



**What fires can I use a Fire Blanket on?** Cooking fires are the most common examples, with a fire blanket being ideal for use on cooker hobs, pans, and fat fryers. But they are also excellent for extinguishing clothing fires when the right technique is used. Fire blankets are recommended for use on dustbin fires since using the wrong fire extinguisher could make the problem worse.

**What features?** Fire blankets from UltraFire come in three sizes to suit your needs, from home use up to industrial kitchens or workshops. Each blanket is encased in a durable, rigid, moulded PVC base-opening case and fitted with dual pull tapes.
