CARAVAN FIRE SAFETY TIPS

EMERGENCY SERVICES DIAL 999



- Site your caravan 6 metres from other caravans
- Locate the firefighting equipment on camp
- Check your own extinguishers are in good working order



- Ensure you have at least one smoke or heat alarm
- Test your smoke alarm regularly
- Ensure you have new batteries at the start of a new season



- Do not leave your cooker unattended
- Turn pan handles away from you when cooking
- Have a fire blanket in your kitchen area



- CO is a toxic gas caused by faulty gas burning appliances such as heaters
- CO poisoning can be fatal
- Symptoms of CO poisoning include: headaches, sore throats and drowsiness
- Ensure you have a CO alarm



- Do not overload electricity sockets
- Ensure heaters are never blocked or covered
- Check your appliances regularly for worn cables



- Plan your escape route
- Keep the exit route clear at all times
- Ensure you have a break glass hammer
